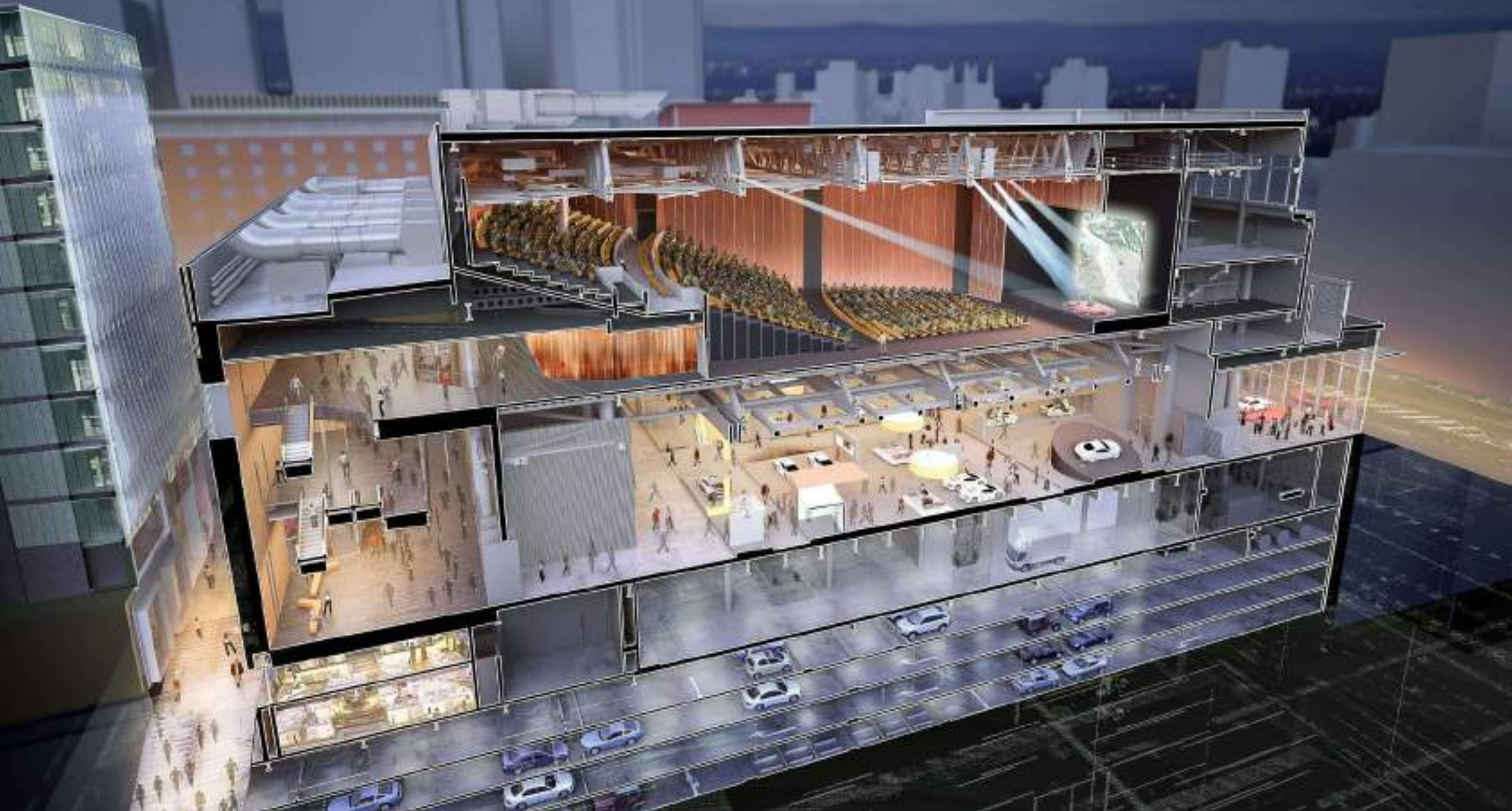



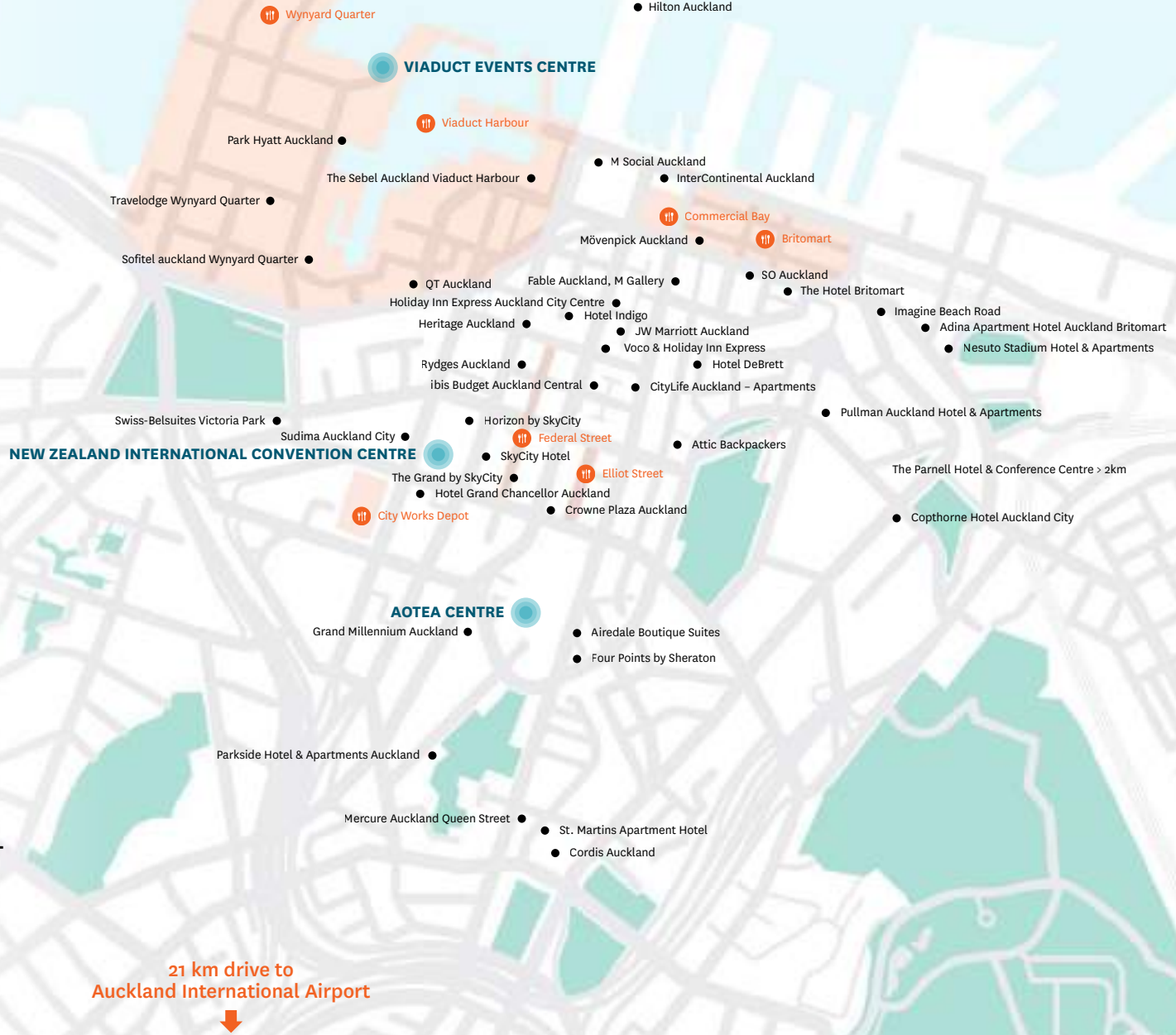

EXPERIENCING MĀORI CULTURE

Cultural connection

New Zealand's unique identity is deeply shaped by its indigenous Māori culture, offering opportunities to incorporate rich, authentic experiences found nowhere else in the world.

Bringing te ao Māori—the Māori worldview—into your conference fosters deeper connection, encourages fresh thinking, and can lead to more meaningful outcomes for both hosts and delegates.

Ways to authentically integrate Māori culture include:

- Involving Māori representatives into the organising committee
- Weaving Mātauranga Māori (Māori knowledge) into the event programme
- Embedding Māori values throughout the event
- Opening with a pōwhiri or mihi whakatau (ceremonial welcome)
- Starting each day with a karakia (incantation or prayer)
- Engaging a Māori MC, facilitator, or guest speaker
- Select culturally significant venues or include a cultural performance
- Promote Māori tourism experiences before or after the event.

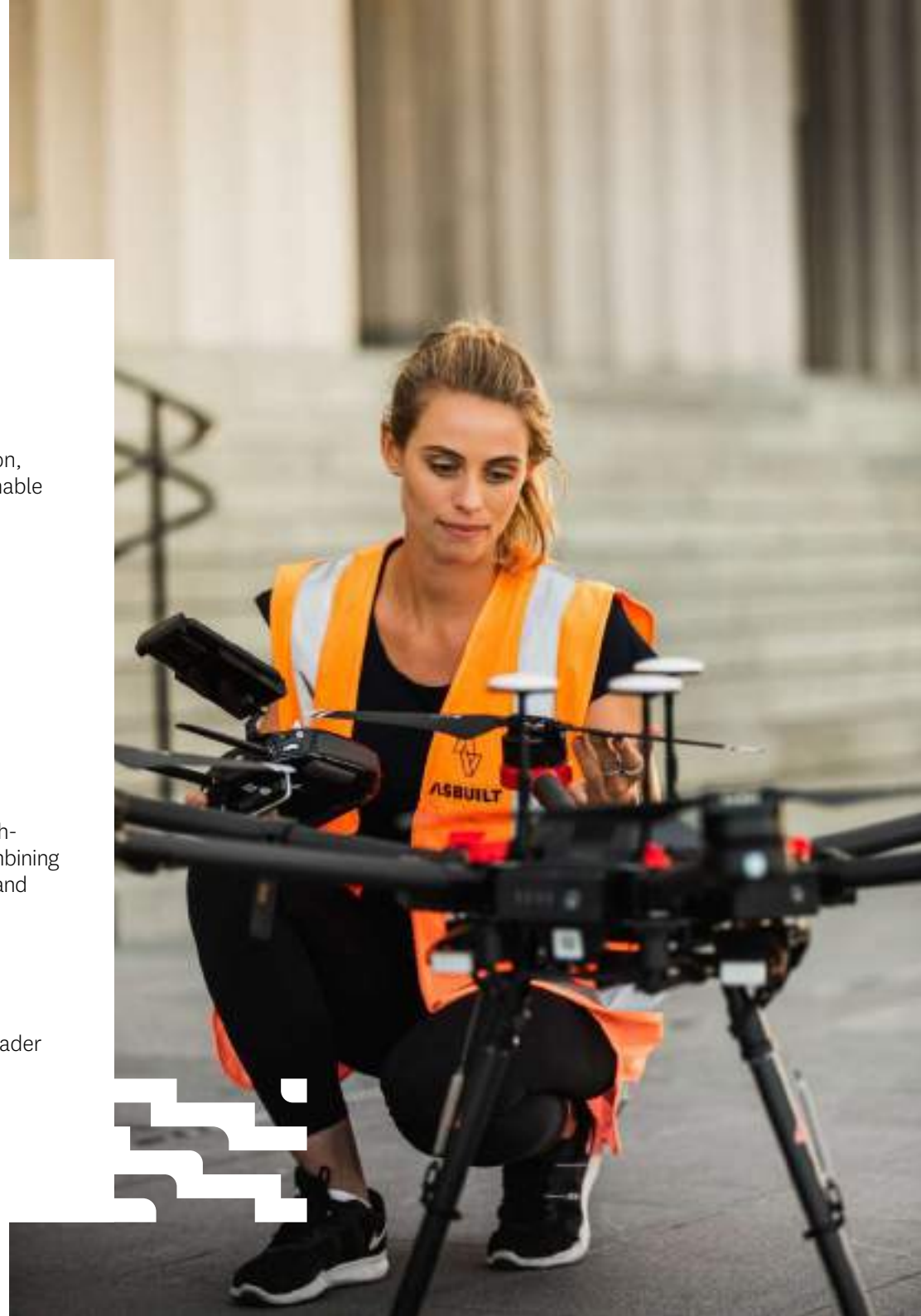
